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#### Create Your Own Paper Boat Story Booklet

#### **Step-by-Step Instructions:**

- 1. Read the Poem "The Paper Boats "by Rabindranath Tagore of chapter 2 from Rain Lily. Think about the paper boats and their journey described in the poem.
- 2. Imagine your own paper boat adventure story. Where do the paper boats go? Who are the characters? What challenges do they face? Plan your story in your mind or jot down some ideas on paper.
- 3. Using your ideas from step 2, write your own paper boat adventure story. Start with a catchy title and then begin writing your story in A4 size colorful papers (excluding dark colors) Write in short sentences and use simple words to describe what happens.
- 4. Draw or paint pictures to go along with your story. You can draw paper boats, characters, and scenes from your story. Use colorful markers, crayons, or pencils to make your illustrations bright and beautiful.
- 5. Now it's time to put your story and illustrations together. Fold some sheets of paper in half to make a booklet. Staple the pages together along the fold to keep them in place.
- 6. On each page of your booklet, write part of your story and draw the corresponding pictures. Be sure to leave enough space for your illustrations next to your writing.
- 7. Once your story and illustrations are in place, you can decorate the cover of your booklet with more drawings or designs. Make your booklet colorful and fun!
- 8. Review your booklet to make sure everything looks neat and tidy. Check for any spelling mistakes or smudges on your drawings. Make any necessary corrections.





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9. Show your completed paper boat story booklet to your family and friends and submit to your English teacher after the summer vacation on the first day of school reopening. Read your story aloud and share your illustrations with them. They'll love hearing about your paper boat adventure!








### **II. Suggested Reading**











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Draw a picture of human skeleton on a chart paper and label it.


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Show the reason for the change in seasons. Prepare a craft to show the reason for the change in seasons.
